**CATHOLIC CERTIFICATE IN RELIGIOUS STUDIES (CCRS):** the next Course, organised by our Own Lancastrian Diocese, starts online in September. Canon Luiz Ruscillo, the Head of the Diocesan Education Service, writes:

“The CCRS course is offered for catechists, teachers and others who may be interested in deepening their knowledge of the Catholic Faith. The course allows for flexibility of study time to suit people's busy lifestyles. The first online CCRS module is an introduction to the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

The CCRS is generally regarded by the governing bodies of primary schools as an essential qualification for those seeking appointment in a Catholic School and for all those aspiring to leadership posts.

Catechists and parish readers have found the modules on sacraments and scripture particularly useful. We are confident that they and perhaps other members of the Parish will find the introduction to Catechism of the Catholic Church both exciting and inspiring.”

**THE ANNUAL PILGRIMAGE TO THE DIOCESAN SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF LOURDES AT CLEATOR, CUMBRIA** is on Sunday, 11 September. The principal celebrant and preacher will be Bishop Michael Campbell. Fr Paul Johnstone, the Parish Priest, writes:-

“This year we honour Our Lady, who does not draw attention to herself but points to her son Jesus, our Way, our Truth and our Life.

As well as having a beautiful replica of the Lourdes grotto, we also have in the grounds of the shrine at Cleator statues of the Curé of Ars and of St Therese of Lisieux. The pilgrimage will be an opportunity not only to honour Mary the Mother of God, but also these two great saints and to ask their intercession for healing and consolation. As usual we invite the young people of our Diocese to walk in pilgrimage from Honister across Haystacks into Ennerdale then on to Cleator. They will begin their journey at Castlerigg Manor on Friday, 9<sup>th</sup> September arriving here on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> September.
