This weekend, at both churches, the bi-annual CAFOD Fast Day Appeal envelopes will be distributed. The Fast Day is next Friday, 5 October, when we try to have a simple meal and give what we save. All the gifts from our Parishes will literally save lives.

At each Mass this weekend, 29th/30th September our Parishes CAFOD representative, Sue Ward, will tell us about the theme of this year's Appeal.

MONDAY, 1 OCTOBER is the Feast of St Teresa, and at the 9.30 am Mass our school children and staff are joining us to celebrate the Feast, and to remember others by bringing their Harvest gifts. All are very welcome.

SINGING THE PSALM The Psalms are biblical songs that are meant to be sung and the instruction in the Roman Missal says that, where it is possible, the Responsorial Psalm and the Alleluia verse should be sung. So from this Sunday, at the 10.30 am Mass, instead of reciting the words of the song, the Responsorial Psalm and Alleluia will be sung. The organ will play the tune of the Response, the cantor (leader of the singing) will sing the Response, then the congregation will sing the Response. Then the Cantor will sing the verses and the congregation will sing the Response at the end of each verse.
