THIS SUNDAY – DAY FOR LIFE: Each year *Day for Life* provides an opportunity to reflect on the dignity of every human person, both young and old, and to pray for and support all life from conception to natural death. This year's *Day for Life* provides us with an opportunity to reflect, to pray and to offer practical and emotional support, especially for those who have lost a child and for those women who are anxious about their pregnancy. As we approach the 50th anniversary of the Abortion Act in October, we mourn the large annual number of abortions and continue to pray for the care and support of mothers and their children in the womb. Pope Francis, reminding us of the consistent teaching of the Church, describes abortion as a grave sin. However, as a compassionate pastor he reminds priests that they are called to be ministers of God's mercy. He also points out that we have not done enough to support and accompany pregnant women in desperate circumstances.
