“The CCRS course is offered for catechists, teachers and others who may be interested in deepening their knowledge of the Catholic Faith. The course allows for flexibility of study time to suit people’s busy lifestyles. The first online CCRS module is an introduction to the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

The CCRS is generally regarded by the governing bodies of primary schools as an essential qualification for those seeking appointment in a Catholic School and for all those aspiring to leadership posts.

Catechists and parish readers have found the modules on Sacraments and Scripture particularly useful. We are confident that they and perhaps other members of the Parish will find the introduction to the Catechism of the Catholic Church both exciting and inspiring.”
