CAFOD, our own country's Catholic Agency for Overseas Development, is well known for not only coming to the aid of people because of some emergency crisis (as in floods and earthquakes) but also for its great support in helping people to support themselves and develop the means to eradicate hunger, disease and poverty.

This year CAFOD are asking our help in their campaign to support local, renewable energy which tackles poverty in some of the poorest areas of the world. One in six people are still living without electricity, and the hopes of millions of the world's children are all too often a distant dream. Renewable energy can transform lives for children, so they don't have to rely on unpredictable and dangerous energy sources such as candles, paraffin lamps and firewood.

The UK spends money on energy access for the poorest communities through the World Bank. This is supposed to help tackle poverty, yet currently only a tiny proportion of World Bank Energy spending supports the kind of energy that we know benefits the poorest communities.
