FURTHER INFORMATION, FROM BISHOP PAUL, AFTER THE SAD ANNOUNCEMENT OF CANON TOM DAKIN'S death on 18 February:

“Canon Dakin was born on 8 July, 1926, in Lancaster. He was educated at the Cathedral Catholic Primary School, Lancaster. He attended St Joseph's, Upholland for junior seminary and the Venerable English College, Rome for Senior seminary. He was ordained on 22 December 1951 in the Lateran Basilica, Rome. He served as Assistant Priest at St Joseph, Preston, from 1953 to 1955 and St Walburge, Preston, from 1955 to 1964. He taught at Underley Hall from 1964 to 1968, then served as assistant priest at Sacred Heart, Thornton, from 1968 to 1970. He was then appointed as Parish Priest of Sacred Heart, Thornton until 2002. In addition, he was chair of the Liturgy Commission since 1970. He moved to be Parish Priest of St Nicholas Owen, Thornton in 2002 until 2017. He retired from ministry on 7 January 2017.

The Deanery Mass will be celebrated by Fr Michael Murphy at Sacred Heart, Thornton, on Monday, 11 March 2019 at 7.30 pm. The Requiem Mass will be celebrated at Sacred Heart, Thornton on Tuesday, 12 March 2019 at 11.30 am, followed by burial at St John's, Poulton-le-Fylde.

I offer my sincere condolences to his brother Gerry, Veronica his housekeeper and all his family, friends and brother priests. An outstanding priest, gentleman and scholar. May he rest in peace.”
