THIS WEEKEND WE CELEBRATE THE ANNUAL DAY FOR LIFE: This year the Day for Life will focus on all those who are suffering or have survived domestic abuse. It provides an opportunity to pray, reflect, and to choose the ways in which action, as well as practical and emotional support, can ensure the dignity of human life is upheld at every stage of a person's life. Following discussion about violence in the home and domestic violence at the Synod on the Family, Pope Francis wrote, 'Unacceptable customs still need to be eliminated. I think particularly of the shameful ill-treatment to which women are sometimes subjected, domestic violence and various forms of enslavement which, rather than a show of masculine power, are craven acts of cowardice. The verbal, physical and sexual violence that women endure in some marriages contradicts the very nature of the conjugal union.' (Amoris Laetitia 54).

Within the Bishops' Conference, a small working group (Domestic Abuse Working Group) meets with groups working on the ground as well as with members of the CARITAS network. We are aiming to develop networks and work with others to support projects against domestic violence since Jesus tells us, "I came that they may have life and have it abundantly." (John 10:10). Many people do not have life to the full because they are abused in their own homes. They have fallen victim to the scourge of domestic abuse which is an assault on a person's innate human dignity.
