**#RED WEDNESDAY** on Wednesday, 27 November 2019 the Catholic Church of St John the Evangelist, Poulton, will be lit up red as a way of highlighting all those who suffer persecution as a result of having a faith. Red is the Christian colour of martyrdom. The aim of #Red Wednesday is to shine a light on the injustices perpetuated against all faith groups. An important right of people is to be able to have a faith and to celebrate this openly. In an increasingly secular society, less tolerance is shown to those who have a faith.
