**THE REDEDICATION OF ENGLAND AS THE DOWRY OF MARY** In their November 2017 meeting the Bishops agreed to the re-dedication of England as the Dowry of Mary on or around the Feast of the Annunciation 2020 (25 March).

The re-dedication in 2020, unlike the dedication of King Richard II in 1381, will not be the gift of the country of England, but the personal gift of the faith of the people of England to the Mother of God, to seek her help in building a strong spiritual foundation for the New Evangelisation. We call upon Our Lady to guide and protect our country in the years to come that the people of our country may work together to build a Common Good, as we seek to embrace the truth of the Gospel, that inspires us to create a culture that respects life, embraces the great diversity of our people, and inspires all to a greatness of heart that will serve our community, seeking the good of others before ourselves, especially the poor and marginalised of our world.

Part of the Spiritual preparations will be the Dowry Tour, where the statue of Our Lady of Walsingham from the Slipper Chapel is visiting every Catholic Cathedral in England. An exhibition explaining the Dowry of Mary will be on show, along with a programme of prayer and talks. The Dowry Tour reaches our Cathedral in Lancaster on 6 February, till the 8 February. A full programme of events, including Mass each day, can be found on the noticeboard at the back of church.

**"THE GOD WHO SPEAKS"** The Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales have also decided to dedicate 2020 as a year of focus on the Bible and *The God who Speaks*. In response to this the Xaverian Missionaries now based in Fulwood, Preston, are hosting various events to look at Biblical themes that we encounter throughout the year. All the events take place on Saturdays from 10 am to 2 pm at the Xaverian Mission Spirituality Centre (formerly Tabor), 169 Sharoe Green Lane, Fulwood, Preston, PR2 8HE, [preston@xars.org](mailto:preston@xars.org), Tel 01772 717122.
